Robert Tibi joined the Shreveport-Bossier Military Affairs Council as Executive Director in February of this year. In addition to his role with the MAC, Rob occasionally administers military entrance exams for the Shreveport Military Entrance Processing Station in high schools across the region and performs career counseling for students and prospective recruits. He has a Bachelor of Science in Management from Park University and a Master of Arts degree in Business and Organizational Security Management from Webster University.

Rob is a third generation Air Force veteran who entered the Air Force in December 1993 as a Munitions Systems Specialist. His journey through the Air Force includes assignments in Texas, Colorado, North Carolina, Arizona, New Mexico, Louisiana and two tours in South Korea. Additionally, he has deployed to Saudi Arabia, Guam, Afghanistan, and the United Arab Emirates.
