

This world-class air show featured: The U.S. Air Force Thunderbirds, U.S. Army Golden Knight, the Smoke n Thunder Jet Truck, Randy Ball's FighterJets Inc. MiG-17s, Red Bull Air Force, Nate Hammond GhostWriter, Titan Aerobatic Team, Quicksilver Air Shows P-51 Mustang, Army Aviation Heritage Foundation's Sky Soldiers, numerous heritage aircraft, BAC Jet Provost, Jeremy "Gunner" Holt's bi-plane, a flightline packed with static display aircraft and so much more!

The **Shreveport-Bossier Military Affairs (MAC) Scholarship Fund** was established in 2013, and reauthorized by the Board of Directors in March 2022. The mission of the scholarship fund is to provide financial assistance to individuals enrolled for undergraduate study.

The MAC scholarship provides \$1,000 scholarships to 20 deserving Airmen each year to support them in their academic journey while they simultaneously work to preserve America's freedom! This year, we are excited to offer you again, the opportunity to have a scholarship award named after you for a donation of \$1,000 or more, and an opportunity for you to personally present the award to the recipient at our scholarship awards luncheon to be held in July. Solicitation letters will be mailed soon so please watch your mailbox and support this worthy program!

New this year the MAC has assumed administrative control of the Lt. General (Ret.) Edgar Starr Harris, Jr. Scholarship, which was established in 2010 to benefit students planning to pursue a professional career in the United States military. Preference is given to students interested in a career with the U.S. Air Force and to dependents of Air Force members currently serving or who have served at Barksdale Air Force Base. The scholarship is named in honor of Lt. General (Ret.) Edgar Starr Harris, Jr., who served as commander of the Eighth Air Force, Strategic Air Command, with headquarters at Barksdale Air Force Base. While the MAC controls the administrative aspects of this scholarship it is still funded by a grant from the Community Foundation of Northwest Louisiana. This year's award will be \$1,821.

All scholarships will be presented at our **July Scholarship Banquet on 30 July 2025 ay 5:30pm at the Petroleum Club of Shreveport** — save the date on your calendars!
