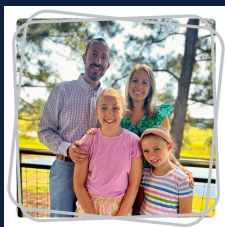

Grant Nuckolls

6th Generation Shreveporter / Entrepreneur

Grant Nuckolls is a 6th generation Shreveporter, proud to live and work in his hometown. After receiving a Bachelor's and Master's Degree in Finance from Tulane University, Grant moved back to Shreveport where he worked for Hardware Resources in Bossier City. There, he managed a \$50million product line, often traveling to China to oversee sourcing, quality control, and new product development.

Grant then turned his attention to a new career – foodservice. In 2019, he and partner Andrew Crawford purchased Jacquelyn's Café, a popular lunch destination which has been continuously operated since 1983. In 2020, the duo purchased Cuban Liquor, a retailer of gourmet foods and spirits, and one of the oldest continuously operated liquor stores in the region, founded in 1934. The group's latest venture is a dual-branded coffee and donut concept which opened in June 2023, featuring two of the area's most iconic brands under one roof – Southern Maid Donuts and Rhino Coffee. Most recently, Grant has joined his father and cousin as an operating partner in their family business, Twin Cities Car Wash, opened by his father and uncle in 1984.

He also volunteers by serving on area boards, including: The Strand Theatre, North Louisiana Jewish Federation, Independence Bowl Foundation, Shreveport Bossier Military Affairs Council, Shreveport-Bossier Committee of 100, Louisiana Committee of 100 for Economic Development, and Boy Scouts of America Norwela Council. He has previously served on the boards of the Shreveport Chamber of Commerce, American Rose Center, Shreveport Club, Highland Area Partnership, CoHabitat Foundation, and Renesting Project.

He has contributed to other civic endeavors, including serving on Mayor Tom Arceneaux's Citizens Capital Improvements Committee, the Shreveport Airport Authority, and on the Transition Teams of Shreveport Mayors Tom Arceneaux and Adrian Perkins. Grant has received the United Way's "Clyde E. Fant Memorial Award" in 2024, the Boy Scouts of America Norwela Council's "Silver Beaver Award" in 2024, the City of Shreveport's "Love Shreveport Award" in 2019, the Bossier City Chamber's "Small Business of the Year Award" in 2017, the Shreveport Chamber's "Small Business of the Year Award" in 2016, and the Shreveport Chamber's "40 Under 40 Award" in 2015.

When he is not in his businesses, Grant enjoys traveling and playing guitar. He lives in Shreveport with his wife Ann and daughters Emma (11) and Natalie (8).
