MEMBER HIGHLIGHT

Colonel (Ret) Michael "Mike" Dilda
(AEM) Veterans Health Administration

Colonel Dilda is an Area Emergency Manager (AEM) with the Veterans Health Administration. His role, as Coordinator for the Shreveport Federal Coordination Center (FCC), facilitates federal patient movement operations to area hospitals in Northwestern LA. He started working with the VA following his job with Louisiana Tech Research Institute's (LTRI) Center of Excellence in Secure and Resilient Systems (CESARS). While at LTRI, he led curriculum development and delivery of the Air Force's first Nuclear Command, Control, Communications (NC3) intermediate and advanced academic learning programs. He has also worked with MediaDyne Systems Engineering developing the Air Force's Programming Plan to transfer all E-4B Airborne Command Post authorities and responsibilities away from Air Combat Command and to Air Force Global Strike Command; and for the Deputy Assistant Secretary of the Air Force for Operational Energy – developing Air Force Global Strike Command's Operational Energy Program.

Colonel Dilda retired from the Air Force in December 2014 with extensive experience as a nuclear enterprise staff officer, exercise planner, war planner, and aviator. He is a combat veteran of Operations DESERT STORM, ALLIED FORCE, IRAQI FREEDOM and ENDURING FREEDOM; a key combat planner in Operations DESERT FOX, JOINT TASK FORCE NOBLE ANVIL and ALLIED FORCE; and served 15 months at Camp Taji, Iraq as an Expeditionary Training Squadron Commander and Director of the Base Support Unit. He is a Master Navigator with 3,232 flight hours including 178 combat hours in the B-52. He received his undergraduate degree from Baylor University, his Masters of Science in Computer Systems Technology from Louisiana State University-Shreveport, and Masters of Military Operational Art and Science from Air University. Mike has been with the MAC since 2019, and is the Military Officer's Assoc. of America (MOAA) Ark-La-Tex Chapter President and President of the MOAA Louisiana Council of Chapters. He also volunteers with Louisiana's North Board of the American Red Cross, and Military Relations Committee of the Bossier Chamber. His wife, Mary Beth, is a native of Shreveport.

CURRENCY OF CARING

The MAC is pleased to announce a new partnership in this program to support military members; Steve Watkins has added his two Bossier City, Zaxby's Chicken locations as participating locations and the feedback from Airmen has been tremendous.

This is our newest program, launched 12 November 2024, that works to combat food insecurity among junior enlisted military families. A recent Pentagon study revealed that approximately 25.8% of U.S. military personnel struggle to access healthy food, with 15.4% of those being active-duty service members.

Like all other MAC other programs all of the money collected is used to directly support the Airmen and families of Barksdale AFB. Currency of Caring is a tokenized program where local participating restaurants are reimbursed for providing pre-selected meals to Airmen purchasing meals with the CoC tokens. Airmen receive the meal tokens from the Wing Commander and Command Chief based on need. 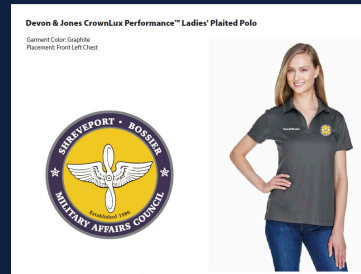
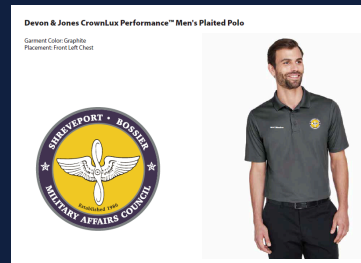
Display Your MAC Pride with a MAC POLO!
